FOOD SUPPORT

The Unity Collective Food Pantry

Located in West Philadelphia, serving Black families, seniors, and people facing food insecurity.

Services: Groceries, produce boxes, diapers, hygiene kits.

The Blackwell Cultural Alliance Community Pantry

A community-run food access program named after the late Councilwoman Jannie Blackwell.

Address: 125 S. 49th Street, Philadelphia, PA

Services: Weekly pantry, cooked meals, essential goods.

Mama-Tee's Community Fridge Network

Free community refrigerators are located across the city.

Services: Food pantry, HIV testing, youth support, and wellness services.

Services: Emergency food access plan due to SNAP pause.

Community Schools Food Distribution

Services: Multiple schools across Philly are offering weekly grab-and-go produce.

Broad Street Ministry

Services: Daily meals + dignity services.

Also offers mail access for unhoused neighbors.

Face to Face Germantown

Services: Hot meals, groceries, legal aid, wellness support.

The Institute for Community Justice (ICJ)

Services: Reentry help, employment, and healing support.

Community Legal Services (CLS)

Services: Help with utilities, housing, employment rights, and public benefits.
